All students will perform in one of the Student Recitals unless enrolled in the **Concerto** elective.

Each student receives a lesson with a master class teacher.

Students age 6 & under: Choose up to **2** electives
Students age 7 & above: Choose up to **3** electives.
Teens may choose **Etudes** class plus **2** electives.

Electives

Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis, with **priority** given to those whose payment has been received.

1. **Eurythmics** - All Ages.
2. **Music in Motion** - Age 12 and under.
3. **Origami** - All ages. Supply Fee of \$10 per student
4. **Drumming** - All ages.

Teacher approval required for the following classes:

5. **Handbells**-Age 7&up. Must be proficient reader.
6. **Triolets**-Must have mastered Minuet 2 in Book 2. Additional fee of \$25 per student. Students will be coached in class with the opportunity to play Suzuki pieces they know well with a violin and cello. Students learn the basics of listening to others while they play.
7. **Concertata**-Bk level 3&up Additional fee of \$40 per student. Students will be coached in class and work with a small chamber orchestra of 4 violins, 2 violas, and 2 cellos.
8. **Duets**-Bk. 3&up. Must be proficient reader. Students will prepare ahead of time both parts of at least 1 duet.
9. **Advanced Duet**-Bk 5&up Additional fee of \$35 per student for extra coaching with Dr. Betty Mallard.
10. **Advanced Chamber Music**-Late Book 5&up. Additional fee of \$55 per student. In class coaching on advanced music with violin and cello.
11. **Etudes** -Age 13&up by Jan 10, 2015. Students will discuss etudes in a group class and be coached on an etude they have prepared ahead of time.
12. **Concerto** -Additional fee of \$250. Student will rehearse and perform with a small orchestra ensemble for Sunday's concert.
